



CSEC Youth in Action Mentoring Program Specialist
Full-Time, Hourly–Non-Exempt

Position Summary: This is a shared position between Sacramento City USD and WEAVE. The Program Specialist will be embedded at SCUSD 75% of the time (3 days per week) with Sacramento City Unified School District and 25% of the time (2 days per week) with WEAVE. Monitor the YIA Mentor Program and work with YIA Coordinator and Director to determine the needs and goals of the mentoring program. The Program Specialist will be responsible for the oversight of the guidance and YIA Mentoring Program, ensuring that mentees are matched with YIA mentors who meet their specific needs. Train approved mentors, provide support as well as keep records of mentor program progress. Evaluate and monitor mentor/mentee relationships. Facilitation of WRAP (With Respect and Passion), an early prevention and intervention group for youth who are vulnerable to commercial sexual exploitation. Attend all professional development trainings/activities as assigned by SCUSD Coordinator or Director and WEAVE. Provides advocacy support and peer support, provide emergency transportation and accompaniment services as needed with Supervisor approval. Attend and actively participate in local and regional meetings and trainings related to service provision for trafficking victims. Perform other duties as assigned.

24-hour Support and Information Line

- Provides crisis counseling, crisis intervention, support and information via telephone.
- Provides information about WEAVE services and other appropriate referrals to callers.
- Adheres to mandated reporting laws.
- Conducts phone pre-screenings of clients requesting emergency shelter
- Participates in a rotation with other Response Services staff providing on-call consultation to Support Line Advocates.

Qualifications:

- MSW required
- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited school in Social Work, Psychology, Sociology, or related field is required. Master's Degree preferred.
- Minimum of two (2) years of experience working in the community
- Bilingual (Spanish) communication skills strongly preferred
- Crisis intervention, problem-solving and conflict resolution skills
- Ability to work well independently and as a reliable team member
- Consistent demonstration of positive, cooperative, self-motivated, and professional behavior
- Knowledge of topics specific to commercially sexually exploited youth (i.e. needs, trauma informed care, victimization, mental health needs)

- Able to work and communicate openly and effectively with applicable stakeholders to implement problem solving strategies, understand needs, and to provide services in an ethical, respectful, responsible manner
- Ability to work with individuals from diverse economic backgrounds in a respectful manner
- Excellent communication and documentation skills, written and verbal
- Great organizational skills and ability to manage multiple tasks
- Knowledge and experience in using Microsoft Office suite
- Must successfully complete and pass all background checks
- Transportation, valid CA Driver's license, state minimum auto insurance, and must meet district and/or WEAVE driving standards
