



Short Term

1. Enhance Language Access
2. Develop emergency response team for marginalized communities impacted by crisis. Emotional first-aid/post-vention
3. More support for Tribal communities
4. More tools for remote court and legal services and access for survivors to legal documents
5. Increased funding for prevention
6. Training for new Executive Directors
7. Technical assistance for leadership, especially women of color who are not necessarily high level managers, and strengthening culturally specific and culturally responsive services within mainstream organizations.
8. Create materials, tools, & TA for programs working with these survivors. This could fall under the new policy position.
9. Programmatic prevention development
10. More regional support around issues related to LGBTQ youth.
11. Re-imagine regional and statewide calls
12. Housing security
13. Host workshops on building alliances amongst and with POC organizations.
14. Evaluation

Long Term

1. Language justice practice
2. The Partnership to make space for Tribal communities and build intentional relationships
3. Focus on policies that impact Tribal communities
4. Increase and improve legal services from advocates in urban and rural areas.
5. Change structure of Batterer Intervention Programs from the criminal justice-based approach to a clinical/healing approach.
6. Strategies for sustainable prevention programming and increased funding for prevention
7. Expand on how gender based, and family-based violence affect youth.
8. Train the trainer for BIP graduates
9. Policies and Procedures for new Executive Directors and their organizations
10. Alliance and training for law-enforcement and the judicial system to be trauma informed/victim centered
11. Policy to sustain resources for undocumented and unhoused survivors
12. Prevention curriculum that is community based and sustainable prevention programming
13. Relationship building with law enforcement
14. Restorative Justice work
