Program Advocate Coordinator Full-Time

Must have or be able to earn a 40-Hour Training Certificate within six months of hire; Bachelor's degree preferred; or High School Diploma and a minimum one year's experience working with a population facing issues of homelessness, mental illness, substance abuse, medical issues, and domestic violence; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

- Provide supervision, crisis intervention, and peer support to shelter residents
- Fill in shifts across the program as needed, facilitate or supervise client meetings
- Conduct or assist shelter staff with case management duties, health screenings, child care, intake and exit assessments
