In 2016, Governor Brown signed AB 1399 into law, creating the first California Domestic Violence Victims Fund. This fund allows Californians to support domestic violence survivors through their individual state tax returns.

The California Domestic Violence Victims Fund is included in your tax forms as a voluntary contribution line item on Form 540, Side 4, Line 14, Code 433. The money will be distributed by Office of Emergency Services to non-profit domestic violence programs all across California.
